What is Dental Core Training?



- A period of supported postgraduate development which extends from the end of Dental Training to the start of Specialty Training, general practice or other available career options
- 3 separate 12-month fixed term programmes
- Competency based and assessed with an ARCP at the end of each year

- Learn to manage patients referred from Primary Care with complex medical and dental conditions
- Become part of a large multidisciplinary team
- Develop clinic, communication and leadership skills
- Develop your preference career choice



Review of competency progression (RCP)

Assessment timeline





- At least 24 SLEs in each 12 month period.
- Must vary to cover curriculum and should capture the breadth of training experiences.
- Different types (CBD, mini CEX, DOPs)
- With as many different trainers as is practical.
- A multi source feedback is expected



Review of Competency Progress (RCP)

Formal process

 A panel assesses evidence provided by the trainee and makes judgements on progress against the expected learning outcomes

• IRCP 3 March 2026

• FRCP 4 August 2026

Timelines



• Self assessment, PDP and initial appraisal with ES

Interim RCP – Tuesday 3 March 2026

Final RCP – Tuesday 4 August 2026





- Completion of a minimum of 24 SLEs
- Completion of a clinical governance/quality improvement project
- Submission of a current PDP and progress against that PDP.
- Study Day attendance record and CPD log
- Completed MSF
- Evidence of satisfactory patient feedback
- Evidence of formal sign-off of the trainee's period of training by the Educational Supervisor
- At least 1 SLE Developing the Clinical Teacher



RCP Outcomes

- Outcome 1: successfully achieved the predefined competence and other requirements of the post.
- Outcome 2 (IRCP only): Development of specific competences/capabilities required – Additional training time not required
- Outcome 3: Inadequate progress Additional training time required
- Outcome 4: Released from training.
- Outcome 5: Incomplete evidence presented
