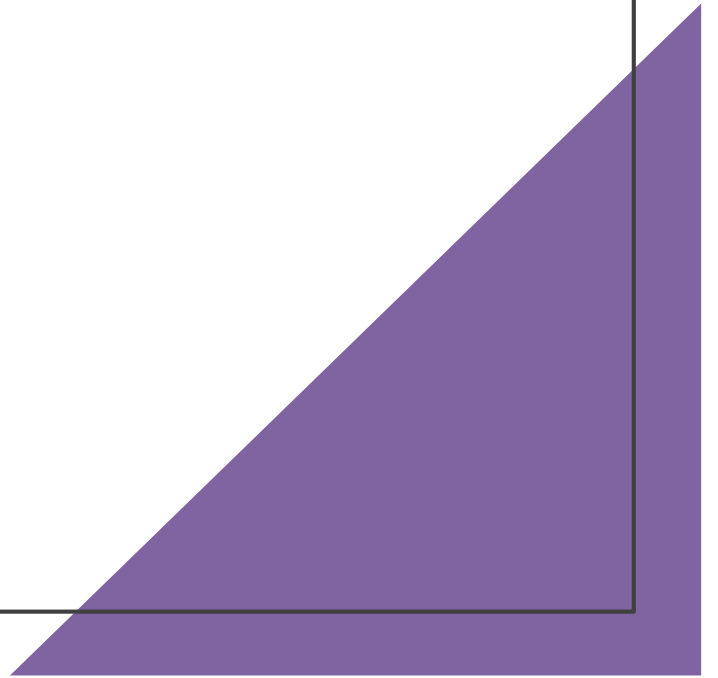

- Severe medical and surgical problems to ensure the best treatment outcome.

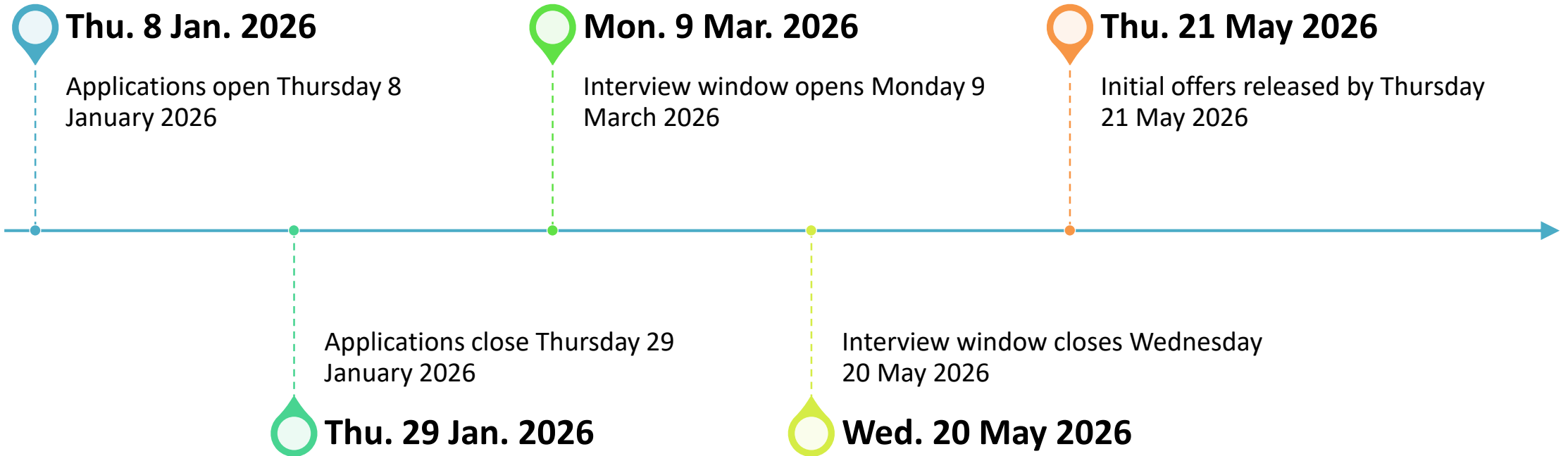


Life as a Restorative StR

Interview Format

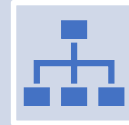
- Virtual format
- Three stations:
 - 2x clinical scenario
 - 1x combined management case and patient factor case
- 1 hr total
- Weighted to clinical scenarios
- Interview breaks ties

Have a structure (but be flexible)
