Brid Hendron

Postgraduate Dental Dean, NIMDTA

Ms Brid Hendron was appointed to the role of Postgraduate Dental Dean at the Northern Ireland Medical and Dental Training Agency in 2016. Brid oversees all postgraduate dental education and the continuing education programme for dental practitioners and dental care professionals in Northern Ireland.

Brid is a Fellow of the RCSEd Faculty of Dental Educators, a Senior Founding Fellow of the FMLM and a qualified NLP trainer.



Professor Avijit Banerjee

Professor of Cariology & Operative Dentistry, Faculty of Dentistry, Oral & Craniofacial Sciences, King's College London & Hon. Consultant, Restorative Dentistry, Guy's & St. Thomas' Hospitals Foundation Trust, London

An internationally recognised expert in cariology, minimum intervention oral care and minimally invasive dentistry, Avi has published extensively and authored several leading textbooks. He currently serves as Dean of the Faculty of Dentists at the College of General Dentistry, President of the British Society of Oral and Dental Research, and Editor-in-Chief of the British Dental Journal portfolio. He is the recipient of the IADR William H Bowen Distinguished Scientist Award and the BDA John Tomes Medal.



Dr Annie Hughes

BA, BDentSc, MFD (RCSI), DChDent (Prosthodontics), FFD (RCSI)

Dr Annie Hughes is a Prosthodontist who graduated with First Class Honours from Trinity College Dublin in 2019, where she received both the Dental Council Restorative Prize and the Sheldon Friel Prize. She subsequently completed a three-year clinical doctorate in Prosthodontics at Trinity College Dublin, alongside research with Sport Ireland examining diet and oral health in elite athletes.

Annie completed both her Membership and Fellowship examinations with the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland. She currently works in private practice at Hampton Dental and holds a part-time supervisory role at the Dublin Dental University Hospital. Her clinical interests include fixed, removable, and implant prosthodontics.

Phil Tomson

Senior Clinical Lecturer & Honorary Consultant in Restorative Dentistry, University of Birmingham

Phil completed higher specialist training in 2011 and holds GDC specialist registration in Restorative Dentistry, Endodontics, Fixed and Removable Prosthodontics, and Periodontics. His research interests include tissue regeneration, vital pulp therapies, root canal disinfection and innovative approaches to assessing treatment outcomes.

Phil is actively involved in undergraduate and postgraduate education and regularly lectures nationally and internationally on the management of pulpal and periradicular disease.



Professor Ikhlas El Karim

Clinical Professor, Consultant in Restorative Dentistry and Chair of Endodontology at Queen's University Belfast

Ikhlas completed her specialist training and PhD at Queen's and leads both consultant restorative dentistry services within Belfast Health and Social Care Trust and a research programme in endodontics.

Her clinical and research interests focus on vital pulp therapy and regenerative approaches to pulpal disease. Professor El Karim has published more than 80 peer-reviewed papers, co-edited Vital Pulp Treatment, and is an Associate Editor of the International Endodontic Journal. She is a regular speaker at national and international conferences.



Dr Alaa Bani Hani

Consultant in Paediatric Dentistry, King's College Dental Hospital, London

After qualifying in dentistry in 2006, Alaa completed a Master's degree in Paediatric Dentistry and a PhD at the University of Leeds, before becoming a specialist in paediatric dentistry and subsequently a consultant.

An active researcher and educator, Alaa has published widely in the fields of dental caries prevention, minimally invasive dentistry and dental trauma. She is a regular national and international speaker and has contributed to the development of European clinical guidelines on the management of caries in children.
